We would like to take this opportunity to keep you updated on the goings on within the Early Years Centre!

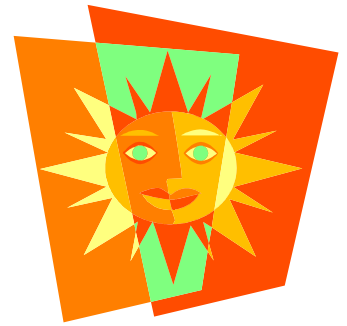
We always welcome parents comments and suggestions, so please feel free to speak to your Childs Keyworker at any-time.

UPDATED CONTACT DETAILS

Please can you ensure that the Centre holds the correct contact details for your child, this is vital as we may need to contact parents urgently if you child is ill.

If anyone other than yourself (Or someone who regularly picks up your child) is due to collect them at the end of the session, you will be asked to provide us with a password, this can then be entered onto your childs details and used in the future.

Please note that no child will be allowed to go home with someone unless a member of staff recognises the adult or a password has been given.



FREE CHILDCARE FOR YOUR CHILD !

All children regardless of their circumstances are entitled to 15 hours free childcare the term after they turn three, we can also offer up to 15 hours free a week for 2 year olds (Subject to you meeting the funding criteria) If you think

you may be entitled to funding, please see the school office, we will be only to happy make the claim on your behalf. If you wish to change your child's current sessions, we are able to do this on a half termly basis. If you wish to do this,

please put in a request at the school office, you will then get notification of your child's new hours a week before the end of the term / half term.

• ***Please can you ensure that your child has the following in their school bag:***

- *Named indoor shoes (Velcro or pull on slippers or plimsolls)*
- *Wellies (Named)*
- *A change of clothes*

Payment of School Fees

As a reminder, please can you ensure that your Childs fees are paid for on time, you will be invoiced half termly for the hours / extra hours taken. On this invoice there will be a payment due by date, if we haven't received payment by this date, you will lose your Childs sessions / extra hours.

If paying for your bill is proving difficult, please speak to a member of staff or the office regarding a payment plan.
